Churches and Lockdown 3 - what we can do...

Now we are in our third Lockdown **we can still attend communal worship (Mass)** but we must only sit with our own household or support bubble and we cannot mingle with other households before, during, or after coming to Church. It is good to be able to have the choice of coming to Mass but remember that the obligation to do so is still suspended and it is important not only to be safe but to feel safe. The Church building must be well ventilated (so dress for the cold) and the norms of social distancing, sanitizing and wearing a face covering apply, the directions of the stewards must be followed to ensure everyone else's safety. We have had all this in place for sometime now, and many are familiar with it. During this lockdown, weddings can take place only in exceptional circumstances, baptisms can take place with up to 6 people present, and funerals can take place with up to 30 attendees. (These numbers are Government regulations).

Christmas Crib we continue to leave the Crib scene until February 2nd which is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord (Candlemas), you may like to do the same in your homes as that reminder that God is truly with us, a message of hope and comfort particularly for our times.
